

# 2011 Family Summit Housing Update

As an update to the housing for the 2011 Summit, for those of you who have not yet been placed in a room, we have come up with some alternatives to camping.

There are many rooms still available at the YMCA lodge, but these require a checkout on 8/5. The last few days would be spent at a nearby Super 8 or a cabin at Bass River Resort or Eagle Hurst Ranch (approximately 20 minutes away).

Transportation to and from the Y will be arranged with those Summiteers who take this option and bags can be left in the Summit office the morning of August 5<sup>th</sup> so Summiteers can go about their day on Friday without interruption. August 7<sup>th</sup> is a checkout day so you may choose to depart directly to the airport from your location.

A reminder that tent camping and RV space is still available for the full week. Additionally, cabins at the nearby Boy Scout camp have been made available to us.

**NOTE:** The Y will be releasing all space to the general public on 4/1 so if you are interested in any of these options, please make contact as soon as possible to confirm your lodging, then contact the Summit office either by email, fax or by calling us to confirm your Summit registration.

### **Tent Camping (10 sites)**

-Shower room and bathrooms are available in nearby North Hall

-Includes all meals and the various activities available at the Y

-Cost: \$444 for adults and \$90 for children (ages 6-17). This covers food and activity fee at the Y for the 7 days and 6 nights of the Summit.

### **RV Camping (3 sites)**

-Includes all meals and the various activities available at the Y

-Located near the ranch area

-Cost: \$444 for adults and \$90 for children (ages 6-17). This covers food and activity fee at the Y for the 7 days and 6 nights of the Summit.
